<sup>\*</sup> NHTSA requires motorhomes over 10,000 lbs. GVWR to have lap belts. If a 3-point belt is installed voluntarily, it must meet requirements for 3-point belts Federal law requires child restraint anchorages on vehicles with a GVWR of 8,500 lbs. or less. For further information see FMVSS 225. For purposes of this survey, seat belt system is defined as a system utilizing a lap belt, a shoulder belt, or any other belt or combination of belts installed in a motor vehicle to restrain drivers and passengers, which conforms to federal motor vehicle safety standards. For purposes of this survey, a child restraint system is defined as a device manufactured to transport children in a motor vehicle, intended to be used to restrain, seat or position a child in a motor vehicle and conforms to all applicable FMVSS.
