


# **RV Market Report**

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## **Vehicle Categories**

A recreation vehicle (RV) is a vehicle that is primarily designed as a temporary living quarters for non-commercial recreational and/or camping use and is built to the standards for recreation vehicle as adopted but eh RV Industry Association

#### **Towable RV**

A Towable RV is a recreation vehicle that is mounted on wheels and designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle or can be a portable unit intended to be placed in the bed of a pickup truck. There are four vehicle types classified as towable RVs.

#### **Conventional Travel Trailer**



A conventional travel trailer is a towable RV constructed from rigid materials with a roof, sidewalls, and mounted on wheels. These units are designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle.

#### **Fifth-Wheel Travel Trailer**



A fifth-wheel travel trailer is a towable RV mounted on wheels and designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle with a towing mechanism that is placed above or forward of the tow vehicle's rear axel.

#### **Folding Camping Trailer**



A folding camping trailer is a towable RV constructed with a collapsible roof and partially collapsible sidewalls. This RV is mounted on wheels and is designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle.

#### **Truck Camper**



A truck camper is a towable RV that is designed to be placed in the bed of a pickup truck.

#### **Motorhome**

A motorhome is a recreation vehicle built on a self propelled motor vehicle chassis. There are three vehicle types classified as a motorhome

#### **Type A Motorhome**



A Type A motorhome is constructed on a bare motor vehicle chassis.

#### Type B Motorhome



A Type B motorhome is a motorhome constructed on an automotive grade van chassis.

#### Type C Motorhome



A Type C motorhome is constructed on a cut away automotive grade truck chassis.

#### **Park Model RV**



A park model RV (PMRV) is a recreation vehicle intended to provide temporary living quarters for recreation, camping or seasonal use. PMRVs are built on a single chassis, mounted on wheels with a gross trailer area not to exceed four hundred square feet.

## **April Review**

The RV Industry Association's survey of manufacturers found that April ended the month with 35,375 wholesale shipments, up 3.4% compared to last April. Through the first third of the year, RV shipments are up 10.9% from the same timeframe last year with 133,223 units shipped.

This month, towable RVs accounted for 90.4% of the monthly shipments with 31,982 units, up 4.2% from last April. To date, towable RVs are up 13.5% with 120,512 shipments to retailers. Motorhomes ended the month down (-3.4%) from last April with 3,393 shipments. Year to date, motorhomes are down (-8.7%) with 12,711 units shipped.

#### Towable RVs

Conventional travel trailers closed the month with 24,737 shipments, up 0.6% from April 2024. Through April, conventional travel trailers are up 10.4% with 92,581 wholesale shipments. This month conventional travel trailers account for 77.3% of all towable RV shipments and 70.0% of total RV shipments. Fifth-wheel travel trailers finished April up 23.7% with 6,581 units. To date, fifth-wheel travel trailers are up 28.9% with 24,824 shipments. Folding camping trailers ended the month down (-18.1%) with 399 units shipped. Through April, folding camping trailers are down (-3.1%) with 1,684 units. Truck campers closed the month with 265 shipments, down (-8.6%) from last April. To date, truck campers are up 4.3% with 1,153 units shipped.

#### **Motorhomes**

Type C motorhomes closed the month down (-7.6%) with 1,958 shipments and continue to lead the motorhome category in unit volume by consisting of 57.7% of all motorhome shipments this month. Year to date, Type C motorhomes are down (-8.9%) compared to the same point last year with 7,389 units shipped. Type B motorhomes were up 8.4% from April 2024 with 772 shipments. Cumulatively, Type B motorhomes have 2,835 shipments and are down (-12.3%). Type A motorhomes finished the month down (-2.6%) on 663 shipments. To date, Type A motorhomes are down (-3.7%) with 2,487 shipments to retailers.










## Type B Motorhome Production and Registrations 12/12 ROC







# **RV Wholesale Shipments Compared to PMRV Wholesale Shipments**




# **RV Wholesale Shipments Compared to Car and Light Truck Sales**





**RV Shipment Rate of Change Compared with Index of Current Consumer Sentiment** 





RV Shipment Rate of Change Compared with Index of Consumers' Buying Attitudes



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# **Vehicle Categories**

A recreation vehicle (RV) is a vehicle that is primarily designed as a temporary living quarters for non-commercial recreational and/or camping use and is built to the standards for recreation vehicle as adopted but eh RV Industry Association

#### **Towable RV**

A Towable RV is a recreation vehicle that is mounted on wheels and designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle or can be a portable unit intended to be placed in the bed of a pickup truck. There are four vehicle types classified as towable RVs.

#### **Conventional Travel Trailer**



A conventional travel trailer is a towable RV constructed from rigid materials with a roof, sidewalls, and mounted on wheels. These units are designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle.

#### Fifth-Wheel Travel Trailer



A fifth-wheel travel trailer is a towable RV mounted on wheels and designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle with a towing mechanism that is placed above or forward of the tow vehicle's rear axel.

#### **Folding Camping Trailer**



A folding camping trailer is a towable RV constructed with a collapsible roof and partially collapsible sidewalls. This RV is mounted on wheels and is designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle.

#### **Truck Camper**



A truck camper is a towable RV that is designed to be placed in the bed of a pickup truck.

#### **Motorhome**

A motorhome is a recreation vehicle built on a self propelled motor vehicle chassis. There are three vehicle types classified as a motorhome

#### **Type A Motorhome**



A Type A motorhome is constructed on a bare motor vehicle chassis.

#### **Type B Motorhome**



A Type B motorhome is a motorhome constructed on an automotive grade van chassis.

#### **Type C Motorhome**



A Type C motorhome is constructed on a cut away automotive grade truck chassis.


A park model RV (PMRV) is a recreation vehicle intended to provide temporary living quarters for recreation, camping or seasonal use. PMRVs are built on a single chassis, mounted on wheels with a gross trailer area not to exceed four hundred square feet.





# **PMRV** Wholesale Shipment Map








# **Manufacturers Wholesale Shipments Index Comparisons**

PMRV Shipment Rate of Change Compared with Index of Current Consumer Sentiment




