

## **Vehicle Categories**

A recreation vehicle (RV) is a vehicle that is primarily designed as a temporary living quarters for non-commercial recreational and/or camping use and is built to the standards for recreation vehicle as adopted but eh RV Industry Association

#### **Towable RV**

A Towable RV is a recreation vehicle that is mounted on wheels and designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle or can be a portable unit intended to be placed in the bed of a pickup truck. There are four vehicle types classified as towable RVs.

#### **Conventional Travel Trailer**



A conventional travel trailer is a towable RV constructed from rigid materials with a roof, sidewalls, and mounted on wheels. These units are designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle.

#### **Fifth-Wheel Travel Trailer**



A fifth-wheel travel trailer is a towable RV mounted on wheels and designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle with a towing mechanism that is placed above or forward of the tow vehicle's rear axel.

#### **Folding Camping Trailer**



A folding camping trailer is a towable RV constructed with a collapsible roof and partially collapsible sidewalls. This RV is mounted on wheels and is designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle.

#### **Truck Camper**




A truck camper is a towable RV that is designed to be placed in the bed of a pickup truck.

#### **Motorhome**

A motorhome is a recreation vehicle built on a self propelled motor vehicle chassis. There are three vehicle types classified as a motorhome

#### **Type A Motorhome**



A Type A motorhome is constructed on a bare motor vehicle chassis.

#### Type B Motorhome



A Type B motorhome is a motorhome constructed on an automotive grade van chassis.

#### Type C Motorhome



A Type C motorhome is constructed on a cut away automotive grade truck chassis.

#### **Park Model RV**



A park model RV (PMRV) is a recreation vehicle intended to provide temporary living quarters for recreation, camping or seasonal use. PMRVs are built on a single chassis, mounted on wheels with a gross trailer area not to exceed four hundred square feet.

# **August Review**

The RV Industry Association's survey of manufacturers found that August ended the month with 28,212 wholesale shipments, down (-3.1%) compared to August 2024. Through eight months, RV shipments are up 4.2% from the same point last year with 241,550 units shipped.

This month, towable RVs made up 88.7% of the monthly shipment total with 25,030 units, down (-4.6%) from last August. To date, towable RVs are up 4.6% with 216,757 shipments to retailers. Motorhomes ended the month up 11.3% from last August with 3,182 units. Year to date, motorhomes are up 0.8% with 2,793 shipments.

#### Towable RVs

Conventional travel trailers ended the month with 19,311 units, down (-9.1%) from August 2024. Through two thirds of the year, conventional travel trailers are up 1.0% at 166,191 units shipped. This month, conventional travel trailers account for 77.2% of all towable RV shipments and 68.4% of total monthly shipments. Fifth-wheel travel trailers finished the month with 5,136 units, up 14.8% from the same month last year. Year to date, fifth-wheel travel trailers are up 19.8% with 45,138 shipments. Folding camping trailers closed August with 256 units, up 3.6% from the same month last year. Through August, folding camping trailers are down (-2.5%) with 2,763 units. Truck campers concluded the month up 12.4% compared to last August with 327 shipments. To date, truck campers are up 19.8% with 2,665 shipments.


#### **Motorhomes**

Type C motorhomes closed the month up 8.2% with 1,781 shipments and continue to lead the motorhome category in unit volume by consisting of 56.0% of all motorhome shipments this month. At eight months, Type C motorhomes are up 1.9% with 14,386 shipments. Type B motorhomes were up 14.5% from last August with 783 units shipped. Overall, Type B motorhomes are down (-1.5%) compared to the same point last year with 5,679 shipments. Type A motorhomes closed the month up 16.6% over August 2024 at 618 wholesale shipments. To date, Type A motorhomes are up one unit compared to the same point last year with 4,728 shipments to retailers.

# **Total Shipments Monthly vs. Last Year**












# **RV** Wholesale Shipments Compared to Car and Light Truck Sales




# **Manufacturers Wholesale Shipments Index Comparisons**






RV Shipment Rate of Change Compared with Index of Consumers' Buying Attitudes



# **Vehicle Categories**

A recreation vehicle (RV) is a vehicle that is primarily designed as a temporary living quarters for non-commercial recreational and/or camping use and is built to the standards for recreation vehicle as adopted but eh RV Industry Association

#### **Towable RV**

A Towable RV is a recreation vehicle that is mounted on wheels and designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle or can be a portable unit intended to be placed in the bed of a pickup truck. There are four vehicle types classified as towable RVs.

#### **Conventional Travel Trailer**



A conventional travel trailer is a towable RV constructed from rigid materials with a roof, sidewalls, and mounted on wheels. These units are designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle.

#### Fifth-Wheel Travel Trailer



A fifth-wheel travel trailer is a towable RV mounted on wheels and designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle with a towing mechanism that is placed above or forward of the tow vehicle's rear axel.

#### **Folding Camping Trailer**



A folding camping trailer is a towable RV constructed with a collapsible roof and partially collapsible sidewalls. This RV is mounted on wheels and is designed to be towed by a motorized vehicle.

#### **Truck Camper**



A truck camper is a towable RV that is designed to be placed in the bed of a pickup truck.

#### **Motorhome**

A motorhome is a recreation vehicle built on a self propelled motor vehicle chassis. There are three vehicle types classified as a motorhome

#### **Type A Motorhome**



A Type A motorhome is constructed on a bare motor vehicle chassis.

#### **Type B Motorhome**



A Type B motorhome is a motorhome constructed on an automotive grade van chassis.

#### **Type C Motorhome**



A Type C motorhome is constructed on a cut away automotive grade truck chassis.





A park model RV (PMRV) is a recreation vehicle intended to provide temporary living quarters for recreation, camping or seasonal use. PMRVs are built on a single chassis, mounted on wheels with a gross trailer area not to exceed four hundred square feet.

PMRV Shipment Rate of Change Compared with Index of Current Consumer Sentiment




PMRV Shipment Rate of Change Compared with Index of Consumers' Buying Attitudes


